EMBROIDERY AND CUTWORK

Back

1. Hoop 2 layers of Avalon Plus in hoop
2. Embroider the guide line for the back shape
3. Fold 30cm fabric in half and iron wrong sides together with appliqué paper
4. Embroider guide line for back shape again on this fabric for placing the back onto the front later

Front

1. Hoop 2 layers of Avalon Plus
2. Embroider bookmark front shape design on Avalon Plus only
3. Iron 2 layers of 15cm x 15cm fabric together with appliqué paper
4. Place fabric on top of Avalon plus aligning it with the front shape lines and secure in place with Sewline Glue Stick or Temporary Spray Adhesive
5. Embroider first two lines

6. Cut fabric out along these lines
7. Place enough Avalon on top of the fabric to cover the cutwork outline of the fabric
8. Keep in place with Magic tape
9. Embroider the zigzag
10. Embroider centre appliqué design as well as the satin border for the front of the bookmark
11. Embroider the placement line for the back of the bookmark
12. Remove the hoop from the machine but do not remove the fabric from the hoop
13. Place back fabric on the back of the hoop lining up the guide line with the sewing on the Avalon Plus for the back shape
14. Secure in place with Sewline Glue Stick or Temporary Spray Adhesive
15. Embroider back fabric into place with next step
16. Finish with final satin around the outer edges of the back. This will also attach the back to the front

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
