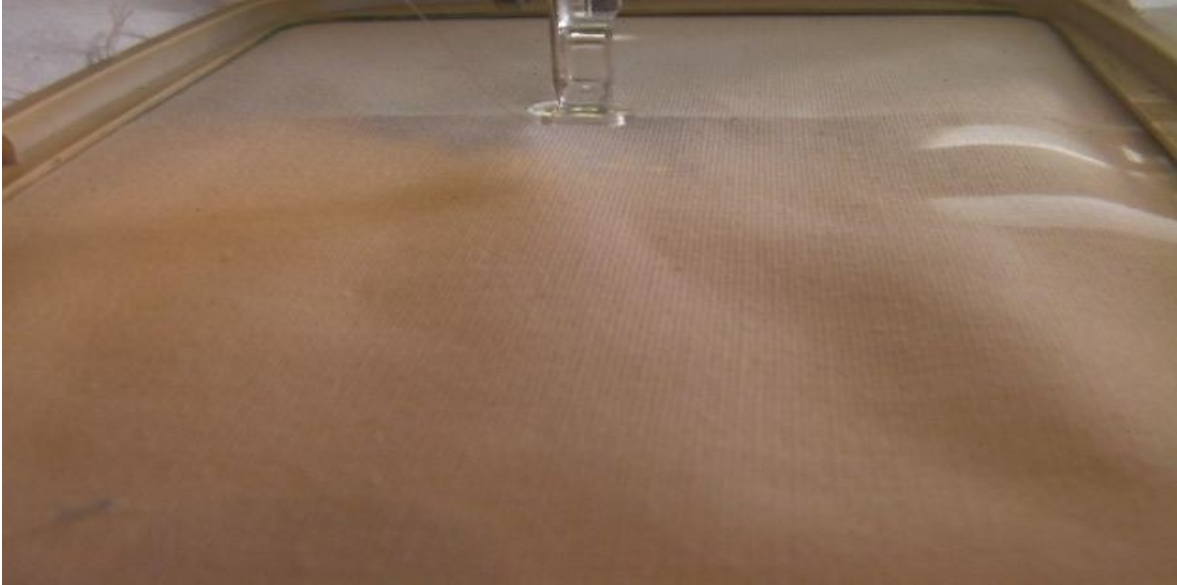


JHB248Freebie

Thank you so much for downloading this freebie. I am sure you are going to enjoy stitching this one. I love birds, so here goes! You can stitch this design with or without mylar. I love the bling of the mylar so of course, mine got mylar LOL! My thread of choice is Marathon threads.

Hoop up your back ground fabric with some tear away stabilizer.



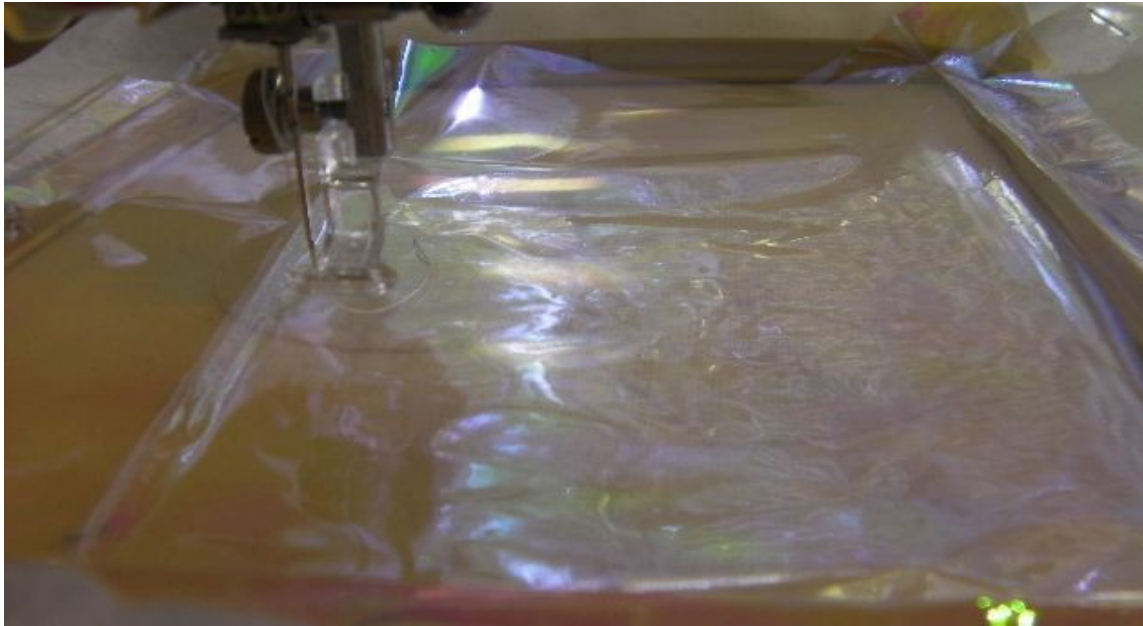
Thread up your machine with a color that matches your back ground fabric. That way the mylar lines disappear and does not show through your bird stitches.

Normal bobbin fill will do.

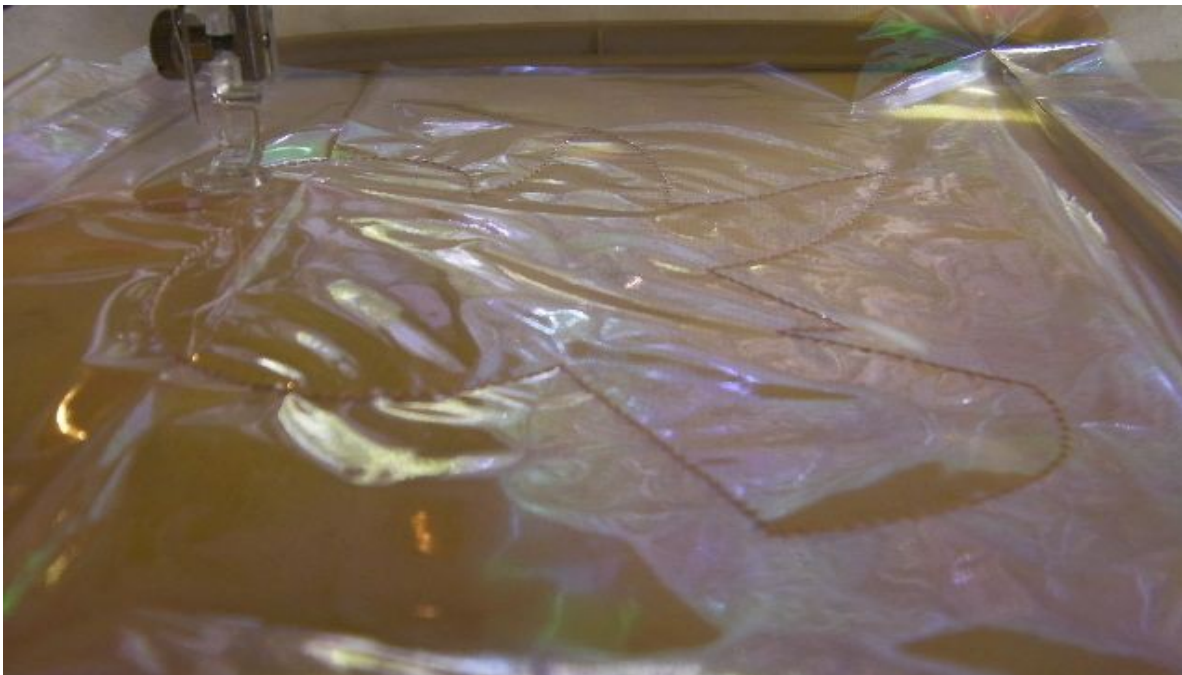
Stitch the first color line. This is the placement line of where your mylar is going to go.



Float your mylar over this placement line.



Secure with the next color line. DO NOT TEAR AWAY EXCESS MYLAR AT THIS STAGE. You only do this after the design is completed.



Now stitch your bird design.

So color number 3 I used brown, number 1161

Color number 4 gray, number 1316

Color number 5 blue 1057 and

Color number 6 is black, 1180

Once you have completed the design you can now tear away all excess mylar.
